We applied HeadsUp on some seed and planted the seed in our pink rot field trial. My post-doc Lyndon Porter also tried a small test. He applied HeadsUp to three plants and three plants he did NOT treat. Four hours later he inoculated the plants with zoospores of Phytophthora erythroseptica. I have attached a picture (in powerpoint) of the results. The plants were randomized when he inoculated, but lined up for the photograph.

I was very impressed! I will keep you posted as to how our other tests turn out.
